This is the first month with the revised workflow in the Recorders Office. The <u>Monthly Shipping List</u> is posted when all titles have a full MARC record in the State Library catalog which you can derive or copy. Please contact us if you have trouble with the Z39/50 deriving or want instructions.

The shipping list is just a shipping list. It contains the minimum of bibliographic information for you to identify the item you received. The cataloging data, including subject and authority headings, are only in the State Library catalog,

Using the new workflow procedures, we are handling incoming documents in weekly batches. If everything stays on schedule, the full cataloging is completed by the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of the following month, e.g. July MSL posted 8/10/07. Tech Srvs and the La Section made this deadline but I held up the MSL for help to figure how to turn the spreadsheet into something more reasonable for you folks.

If we continue to produce the Recorder's bibliographies, PDs & OPs, they will be compiled from the shipping list data. However, the State Library catalog will continue to include all Louisiana depository documents received beginning Jan. 2003. This catalog serves as a complete bibliography 2003- .

Again this month, there are many <u>La Administrative Code</u> revised editions. The Office of the State Registrar website URL has changed recently. The codes are now at <a href="http://doa.louisiana.gov/osr/lac/lactitle.htm">http://doa.louisiana.gov/osr/lac/lactitle.htm</a>. You may want to update your catalog records.

I just noticed that the URL we have used for fulltext <u>Dept. of Natural Resources Coastal Restoration Division reports</u>, <a href="http://www.savelawetlands.org">http://www.savelawetlands.org</a>, has changed to something definitely not documents. Most of the reports can also be found with a search on <a href="http://sonris.com/direct.asp?path=/sundown/cart\_prod/cart\_bms\_avail\_documents">http://sonris.com/direct.asp?path=/sundown/cart\_prod/cart\_bms\_avail\_documents</a> f.

We counted <u>Pennington Biomedical Research Center & Foundation</u> under LSU Health Sciences Centers for distributing docs. We just found out the PRRC is directly under the LSU System now, not with the Health Sciences Centers. We will begin using the LSU System doc distribution numbers, which differ some from HSC:

The foundation publishes an annual report and some other pubs. Because it is private, they may choose not to submit their publications to the depository program. I have asked for annual reports, at least.

The <u>Pennington Biomedical Research Center</u> library staff is sorting out the history of the various newsletters. They will let us know and try to get us

copies of each issue. We will distribute what we can and pass along new cataloging information.

We received an email notification from the <u>LSU AgCenter</u> of several publications that are only in pdf format, not in paper/print. Two of these titles were first published in the 1970s as part of the series: Vegetable Gardening Tips. These titles are in this shipping list, in the Digital Archives. Our AgCenter liaison says: *We printed a lot of publications earlier this year with special grant monies which ended 6/30/07. We will still print publications when funds are available.* 

The email below arrived 7/3/07 from the <u>Port of Lake Charles</u> aka Lake Charles Harbor & Terminal District. Some other boards/commissions have claimed non-compliance with the depository program as a political subdivision.

The Port's attorney, Mike Dees, reviewed the law and requirements of your program. Below is his opinion. As the Port is a local political subdivison of the State, we are not required to send these materials for your program. However, our Accounting Department does send 20 copies each year of the annual financial report to the following: Recorder of Documents ...

You may want to note on your P 200 catalog records that these titles will no longer be received. We will continue to receive:

P 200.1: yr Comprehensive annual financial report: A component unit of the state of Louisiana for the year ended Dec 31...

Executive and special meetings of boards/districts/commissions use the same LaDoc number as the regular meetings so they are filed together. However, they can be distinguished by adding "ex" or "sp" after entire LaDoc number, e.g. PWL 1600.6: May 2004sp for the May 1998 special meeting of the South Terrebonne Tidewater Management & Conservation District.

If you need to distinguish <u>audits of university systems from audits of university system boards</u>, add "BD" to the end of the LaDoc number. Examples:

Louisiana State University System Y 9.2: LSU/date Louisiana State University System Board of Supervisors Y 9.2: LSUBD/date University of Louisiana system Y 9.2: UL/date

University of Louisiana System Board of Supervisors Y 9.2: ULBD/date [Board of Trustees for State Colleges & Universities became University of Louisiana Board of Trustees that later became University of Louisiana System Board of Supervisors]
