<u>Inspector General</u> reports website has recently moved from http://www.state.la.us/oig/reports.htm to <u>http://doa.louisiana.gov/oig/reports.htm</u>. The URL in your catalog records will need updating, Go 101.1: date.

These days, the MSList often has entries for titles put in the <u>Digital Archive</u> (DA). These entries represent docs in electronic format. Following current cataloging rules, the State Library creates a record for electronic format and a separate record for paper format. Usually these are linked but it is important to make sure you have found the record you really need, not just the 1<sup>st</sup> record you come across with that title or LaDoc no. [This is the voice of experience speaking!]

South Louisiana Port Commission changed its name in 1998 to Port of South Louisiana. The State Library and LSU-BR are revising the appropriate catalog records to reflect this. Here are 2 in the State Library catalog: ocm53256797 Louisiana : building blocks for specialty chemicals ocm58721943 Regular meeting of the Port of South Louisiana Commission ...

I asked the La Advisory Council for the State Docs Depository Program for guidance on <u>e-only newsletters</u> from agencies distributed only by email. At least one member felt all of these probably qualify as state docs. However, there are at least 2 titles that I have decided are not state docs:

A. <u>In the News</u>; <u>http://www.lsuhospitals.org/media-</u> <u>relations/in-the-news.htm</u> 1st issue online Jan 3, 2006. Began in 2002 as an in-house means of communicating with employees of the various LSU hospitals around the state; added media and others interested to email distribution. Contains only quoted material from other, outside publications. Our liaison and the head of the LSU NO hospital decided they do not want it as a depository item or to have it archived on DA. I agreed to this since it is not intended for the public. If you want to add this to your collection anyway, you can link to the agency's electronic

archive at the URL listed above and/or print out copies of each issue. The LaDoc would be EL 400.7/11: date.

B. <u>Department of Culture, Recreation & Tourism E-Newsletter</u>, also titled From the Secretary, News and Reviews, or Letter from the Secretary. Emailed to CRT employees; not available to the public on CRT website. Since there is no way for the public to get access to this and it is intended only for employees, I decided it is not a state document. We listed these issues in MSLists from Sept. 2004 through July 2006, Cu 1.7/2: date, 1 copy. The record has been removed from the State Library catalog.

Liaison has no knowledge of the *Operating Budget Request*. Last we received was 1985.

Annual Report. Sandel Library. Last we received was 1978/79. The current year is online; paper format is not available for public distribution but electronic files were submitted for 2003 - 2006.

*University* Identity Standards Manual\_has not been published since the 2004 edition we received.

*Coastal Clips* no. 7 (Summer 2007) describes the <u>GIS instructional videos</u>, which are online, <u>http://www.laseagrant.org/comm/media.htm</u>. I tried to get copies for the depository program but these are only available online. They were developed to bridge the knowledge gap for those who don't know enough about GIS (both hardware and software components) to employ a geographic information system effectively. The 3 presentations total 75 minutes. The 1<sup>st</sup> one introduces the GIS and how it can be applied in Sea grant research and outreach projects. The 2<sup>nd</sup> explores how GIS can be used by local governments. The 3<sup>rd</sup> looks at alternatives to traditional GIS software.

This shipment contains 15 copies of a folder "<u>Black Bear Conservation</u> <u>Committee</u>" that is not a state document. You do not have to keep it. If you want free copies of any of the Committee's publications, contact David Telesco, 225-763-5457. <u>www.bbcc.org</u>. He sent 1 copy of the "Black Bear Management Handbook," again not a state document. They also have an educational CD, including teacher's guide, "Black Bears and Songbirds of the Lower Mississippi River Valley."
